B.2. Maximum number of athletes per National Olympic Committee

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* A maximum of three NOCs may receive two quota places per gender. The remaining NOCs will receive a maximum of one quota place per gender, as specified in section **D, “Qualification pathway”**, under Criteria 2.

B.3. Type of allocation of quota places

Quota places are allocated to the NOC, except the universality place, if available, which is allocated to the athlete by name.

C. ATHLETE ELIGIBILITY

All athletes must respect and comply with the provisions of the Olympic Charter currently in force, including but not limited to Rule 41 (Nationality of Competitors) and Rule 43 (World Anti-Doping Code and the Olympic Movement Code on the Prevention of the Manipulation of Competitions).

Only those athletes who respect and comply with the Olympic Charter, the World Anti-Doping Code and the Olympic Movement Code on the Prevention of the Manipulation of Competitions, including the conditions of participation established by the IOC, plus the rules of the FIG, may participate in the LA28 Olympic Games.

Age requirements

- C.1.** All athletes participating in the LA28 Olympic Games must have been born on or before 31 December 2011, as validated by the passport used for accreditation registration.

Additional IF requirements

- C.2.** To be eligible to participate in the LA28 Olympic Games:

- All athletes must hold a FIG licence that is valid until the end of the 2028 Olympic Games trampoline gymnastics competitions.
- To be eligible for a quota place through a universality place, an athlete must have participated in both the qualification events outlined in section **D, “Qualification pathway”**, as Criteria 1 (WCH) AND Criteria 2 (at least one World Cup of the 2027-2028 qualifying event).
- To be eligible for the two host country quota places, the NOC must have participated in the qualification events (men AND women) outlined in Criteria 1 (WCH), Criteria 2 (World Cups, at least in one qualifying event) AND Criteria 3 (continental championships).

D. QUALIFICATION PATHWAY

Number of quota places	<p>The qualification events are listed in chronological order of qualification. However, hierarchical order is also used in qualification, as mentioned under the specific criteria.</p> <p>In the event of ties for any place, these will be broken using the tie-breaking procedure.</p> <p>An athlete can obtain only one quota place for their NOC.</p>
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D.1. QUOTA PLACES ALLOCATED BY NOC

D.1.1. 2027 World Championships (Nov 2027)

Criteria 1 Participation rights:

Total All FIG member federations in good standing, with a maximum of four men and four women per NOC.
 Min 8 athl.
 Max 16 athl.

Qualification places:

Breakdown The eight highest-ranked male athletes and eight highest-ranked female athletes based on the results of the finals will each obtain one quota place for their NOC, with a maximum of one athlete per NOC.
Women:
 Min 4 athl.
 Max 8 athl.

Men:
 Min 4 athl.
 Max 8 athl.

If two athletes from the same NOC participate in the finals, the highest-ranked athlete in Qualifying Round 2 (Q2) will be taken into account for Criteria 1.

MEN / WOMEN

D.1.2.	2027 and 2028 Trampoline Individual World Cup Series (May 2027 – Apr 2028)
Criteria 2	Six World Cup competitions will be held through this period (three in 2027, three in 2028).
Total	
Min 8 athl.	The three best results out of the six events will be taken into account, regardless of the number of competitions the athletes participated in.
Max 24 athl.	
Breakdown	For each athlete, a maximum of two World Cup qualifying events in 2027 will be taken into consideration.
Women:	
Min 4 athl.	Participation rights:
Max 12 athl.	All FIG member federations in good standing, with a maximum of four men and four women per NOC in each event of the 2027 and 2028 Trampoline Individual World Cup Series.
Men:	
Min 4 athl.	An athlete who obtained a quota place for his/her NOC via Criteria 1 (2027 WCH) may participate but NOT obtain an additional quota place for his/her NOC.
Max 12 athl.	
	Qualification places:
	The highest-ranked male and female athletes based on the Olympic Qualification Ranking List will earn a quota place for their NOC, with a maximum of one per NOC if their NOC has not qualified through Criteria 1.
	The three highest-ranked athletes in the Olympic Qualification Ranking List may obtain a second quota place for their NOC provided their NOC has qualified through Criteria 1.

D.1.3. **2028 continental championships (or another continental qualifying event approved by the FIG)**
Criteria 3

Total

Max 8 athl.

Women:

Max 4 athl.

Participation rights:

All FIG member federations in good standing, with a maximum of four men and four women per NOC.

Qualification places:

Men: Continental Unions are guaranteed a maximum of one quota place per event: one male AND one female athlete, if they have not qualified through other criteria (1 or 2).
 Max 4 athl.

To earn any quota place via Criteria 3 (continental championships), an NOC must have participated, with at least one athlete of the gender concerned, in the qualification events outlined in Criteria 1 (WCH) AND Criteria 2 (World Cups, at least in one qualifying event).

For each gender, the highest-ranked athlete, based on the results of the finals at the continental championships, will obtain one quota place for their NOC, provided the continent has not already qualified for this gender under Criteria 1 or 2. A continental championships edition will be designated as a qualifying event only if the continent has not obtained a quota place through Criteria 1 or 2.

D.2.

HOST COUNTRY PLACES

The host country will be guaranteed one quota place per event (one man AND one woman) if it has not qualified via Criteria 1, 2 or 3.

D.3.

UNIVERSALITY PLACES

One universality place will be made available to eligible NOCs at the Olympic Games provided that the athlete has met the eligibility criteria as described in section C, "Athlete eligibility".

On 1 October 2027, the IOC will invite all eligible NOCs to submit their requests for universality places. The deadline for NOCs to submit their requests is 15 January 2028. The Tripartite Commission will confirm, in writing, the allocation of universality places to the relevant NOCs after the end of the qualification period.

E. CONFIRMATION

Confirmation of quota places

- E.1.** After receiving confirmation from the FIG of the allocated quota places after the end of the qualification period for all gymnastics disciplines, the NOCs will then have two weeks to confirm if they wish to use these quota places, as detailed in section **G**, “**Qualification timeline**”.

After this deadline, unused quota places will be reallocated as per the procedure set out in section **F**, “**Reallocation of unused quota places**”.

Confirmation of host country places

- E.2.** After the final LA28 qualification event, the FIG will inform the host country of its allocated quota places. After receiving confirmation from the FIG, the NOC will have two weeks to confirm if it wishes to use its quota places, as outlined in section **G**, “**Qualification timeline**”.

F. REALLOCATION

Reallocation of unused quota places

- F.1.** If an allocated quota place is not confirmed by the NOC by the confirmation of quota places deadline or is declined by the NOC, or if a 2028 continental championships edition does not take place before 31 May 2028, the quota place will be reallocated to the next highest-ranked NOC in the 2027-2028 Olympic Qualification Ranking List from among the NOCs that have not qualified through any other criteria.

If the 2027 and 2028 World Cup Series does not take place, the unused quota places will be allocated to NOCs as per the individual ranking results of Qualifying Round 2 (or Q1 if athletes did not compete in Q2) at the 2027 World Championships.

Reallocation of unused host country places

- F.2.** In the event that the host country does not use its quota places, the reallocation procedures for unused qualification places listed above in section **F.1** will be used.

Reallocation of unused universality places

- F.3.** In the event that the Tripartite Commission is not able to allocate the universality place, the reallocation procedures for unused qualification places listed above in section **F.1** will be used.
