B.3. Type of allocation of quota places			

Quota places are allocated to NOCs.

Each NOC must, on the recommendation of the corresponding National Federation, select its athletes in line with the criteria set forth in section C, “Athlete eligibility”.

C. ATHLETE ELIGIBILITY

All athletes must respect and comply with the provisions of the Olympic Charter currently in force, including but not limited to Rule 41 (Nationality of Competitors) and Rule 43 (World Anti-Doping Code and the Olympic Movement Code on the Prevention of the Manipulation of Competitions).

Only those athletes who respect and comply with the Olympic Charter, the World Anti-Doping Code and the Olympic Movement Code on the Prevention of the Manipulation of Competitions, including the conditions of participation established by the IOC, plus the rules of the FIVB, may participate in the LA28 Olympic Games.

Anti-doping requirements

- C.1.** The FIVB will only allow the registration of clean athletes who have been tested between the qualification period starting on 26 June 2026 and ending on 26 June 2028.

Additional IF eligibility criteria

- C.2.** To be eligible to participate in the LA28 Olympic Games, all athletes must comply with the requirements set out in [Articles 1 to 5 of the FIVB Sports Regulations](#).

D. QUALIFICATION PATHWAY

NOCs that would like to take part in the qualification events below must complete a registration form. The form must then be returned to the FIVB before the start of the respective qualifying pathway.

The qualification events are listed in chronological order of qualification. The 24 quota places (12 men's and 12 women's) for the LA28 Olympic Games are allocated as follows:

Participants:

- Varied number of nations qualified for the volleyball continental championships through the respective continental qualifiers.

Women:

- Asian Volleyball Championship 2026 in (TBC) between 21 August and 27 September (exact dates TBC);
- African Volleyball Championship 2026 in (TBC) between 21 August and 27 September (exact dates TBC);
- EuroVolley 2026 in (TBC) between 21 August and 27 September (exact dates TBC);
- South American Volleyball Championship 2026 in (TBC) between 21 August and 27 September (exact dates TBC);
- NORCECA Volleyball Championship 2026 in (TBC) between 21 August and 27 September (exact dates TBC). NB: The USA will participate in the 2026 continental championship but will already have a quota place for LA28 allocated as the host of the Games. For the sake of clarity:
 - The NORCECA continental event is played, with the USA participating, to its conclusion.
 - The top four teams (excluding the USA) then play a 1 v. 4, 2 v. 3 semi-final and subsequent final, where the winner qualifies for LA28.
 - The rankings of 1, 2, 3 and 4 are based on where the teams finish in the continental qualifier.

Men:

- Asian Volleyball Continental Championship 2026 in (TBC) between 21 August and 27 September (exact dates TBC);
- African Volleyball Continental Championship 2026 in (TBC) between 21 August and 27 September (exact dates TBC);
- EuroVolley 2026 in (TBC) between 21 August and 27 September (exact dates TBC);
- South American Volleyball Continental Championship 2026 in (TBC) between 21 August and 27 September (exact dates TBC);
- NORCECA Volleyball Continental Championship 2026 in (TBC) between 21 August and 27 September (exact dates TBC). NB: The USA will participate in the NORCECA Continental Championship 2026 but will already have a quota place for LA28 allocated as the host of the Games. For the sake of clarity:
 - The NORCECA continental event is played, with the USA participating, to its conclusion.
 - The top four teams (excluding the USA) then play a 1 v. 4, 2 v. 3 semi-final and subsequent final, where the winner qualifies for LA28.

The rankings of 1, 2, 3 and 4 are based on where the teams finish in the continental qualifier.

Volleyball World Championships 2027 (20 August – 26 September 2027) – women and men

The three highest-placed teams in the final standing of the Volleyball World Championships 2027 per gender are allocated a quota place for the LA28 Olympic Games.

Competition format:

Phase 1: Pool phase (48 matches)

The 32 qualified teams, with eight pools of four teams each, compete in a round robin format.

Phase 2: Round of 16 (16 matches)

The top two teams from each pool (based on the team ranking system: number of wins, then points gained, set quotient, points quotient, team that won the last match, and finally standing in the World Ranking) qualify for the round of 16 and play in a single elimination format until the final match.

Phase 3: Quarter-finals (four matches)

Phase 4: Semi-finals (two matches)

Phase 5: Finals (two matches – gold medal and bronze medal play-offs)

Participants: 32 teams:

- One place: the host (up to four hosts possible)
- One place: current (2025) world champions
- 15 places in total for teams from the 2026 continental championships: the three highest-placed eligible teams in the 2026 continent championship final standing for each of the five continents
- 15 places for teams through the [FIVB Volleyball World Ranking](#) using the FIVB Volleyball World Ranking, up to 15 places will be allocated to eligible teams that have not yet qualified at the end of the 2026 national team season
- NB: If there is more than one host, the number of places allocated through the FIVB Volleyball World Ranking is reduced accordingly (i.e. if 2 Hosts, then 14 places are allocated through the WR)

Two Volleyball World Championships (one per gender) to be held in 2027:

1. Women:
 - Volleyball World Championship 2027 in (TBC), to be held from 20 August to 5 September
2. Men:
 - Volleyball World Championship 2027 in (TBC), to be held from 10 to 26 September

	D.2.	Host country places The host country will be allocated one quota place per gender (one team of 12 men and one team of 12 women) on the condition that the athletes meet the eligibility requirements described in section C, "Athlete eligibility" , of this document.

E. CONFIRMATION

Confirmation of qualification places

- E.1.** Following each qualification event, the FIVB will publish the results on its website (www.fivb.com).
- Ahead of each qualification milestone, the FIVB will notify the respective NOCs and NFs of their potential to qualify and ask for confirmation as to whether they wish to use these quota places, as detailed in section **H, "Qualification timeline"**. If confirmation is not provided before the start of the qualifying pathway, the quota place obtained will be reallocated as per the procedure outlined in section **F, "Reallocation of unused qualification places"**.

Confirmation of Host Country Places

- E.2.** The host NOC must confirm in writing to the FIVB by 1 September 2026 the use of its host country places.

F. REALLOCATION

Reallocation of unused qualification places

- F.1.** If an allocated quota place is not confirmed by the NOC within the confirmation of quota places deadline as detailed in section **H, "Qualification timeline"**, or is declined by the NOC, the quota place will be reallocated to the next highest-placed non-qualified NOC at the event at which the quota place was allocated.

Reallocation of unused qualification places

- F.2.** Unused host country places will be reallocated via the World Ranking qualification pathway as at 11 June 2028 (date TBC) for women and 18 June 2028 for men; the top-ranked team not yet qualified will obtain one quota place for their NOC.

G. AP ATHLETES

Definition

- G.1.** “Ap” athletes are non-competing athletes accredited in the “Ap” category who have different entitlements from competing athletes (accredited as “Aa”), as described in the “Ap” accreditation quotas and conditions outlined in IOC ACR Annex 1 – Accreditation at the Olympic Games – Detailed Specification. These participants are not part of the athlete quota as described in section **B**, “**Athlete quota**”. “Ap” alternate athletes could become competing athletes only under the conditions outlined in the IOC/LA28 Late Athlete Replacement Policy.

Eligibility

- G.2.** “Ap” athletes must comply with the same eligibility rules as competing athletes, as described in section **C**, “**Athlete eligibility**”.

Quota

- G.3.** Each qualified team is entitled to two “Ap” athletes.
